

Course Title: Engaging Families in Support of Student Learning	
Number of Content Modules: 5	Grade Levels: K-12
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Course Description

This course on effective strategies for engaging families in support of student learning will provide educators with the knowledge and skills necessary to establish strong, positive relationships with families and involve them in the educational process. The course will cover key strategies for building connections with families and engaging them in the learning process in ways that are meaningful to them.

Educators will design and implement school-level initiatives that support family involvement and promote student success. They will learn how to create a welcoming and inclusive school culture that supports students' academic and social-emotional development. Educators will earn strategies to build meaningful connections with all families, including those from cultural and linguistic backgrounds different from that of the educator. In addition, the course will examine the role of the teacher in building partnerships with community organizations.

Throughout the course, educators reflect on their teaching practices and apply what they have learned through interactive activities and hands-on exercises. The goal of the course is to empower educators to become confident and competent teachers who effectively partner with families and community members.

Course Objectives

CO.1: Apply evidence-based practices to establish an inclusive school community partnership with families and educators to advocate for student learning opportunities. [Danielson 4b, 4c]

CO.2: Design a culturally responsive-sustaining learning environment by eliminating barriers to the equity that inhibit students from historically underserved and marginalized groups from becoming confident student learners. [Danielson 4c]

CO.3: Interrogate, reflect on, and intentionally address personal and institutional beliefs, norms, and practices that contribute to inequity and prevent learners at the margins from realizing their full potential as productive citizens. [Danielson 4a, 4c]

CO.4: Design inclusive, welcoming, learning partnerships among students, families, teachers, and administrators by employing culturally responsive, asset-focused approaches that build on the funds of knowledge students, their families, and their communities. [Danielson 2a, 2b, 4a, 4c]

CO.5: Reflect in brave learning spaces to a) examine perspectives and experiences of marginalized groups, b) surface and interrogate personal and institutional assumptions, beliefs, and practices that contribute to inequity, and c) reflect on the complex ways identity and culture shape teaching and learning.
